### PROCEDURE

**NOTE** Zombie Axle Cap operation is solely the result of air rushing past the front axle. All products are inspected at the factory prior to packaging for correct operational tolerances. The blades should begin to spin at approximately 25mph and continue to spin at all speeds above that. Starting speed can be affected by several factors; the position of the blades when they stopped spinning, starting out into a strong headwind, starting out with a tailwind, and rain. Once at highway speeds, operation may be affected by crosswinds, strong gusts, wind blasts from large vehicles, etc. Like other moving parts on your bike, periodic maintenance is required; see care and maintenance section for details.

**STEP 1** Park the motorcycle on a hard, level surface; turn off the ignition.

**STEP 2** Determine the left and right side axle caps. See [PIC.1](#). The blades should be oriented to “catch” the wind and spin in the same direction as the front wheel.

**WARNING!** IMPROPER INSTALLATION OR USE OF THIS PRODUCT COULD RESULT IN SERIOUS INJURY OR DEATH.

**ATTENTION!** It is the installer's responsibility to ensure that all of the fasteners (including pre-assembled) are tightened before operation of the motorcycle. Küryakyn will not warranty components lost due to improper installation. Periodic maintenance may be required.

**STEP 3** Hold the caps in position and tighten the set screw against the axle.

**STEP 4** Ensure proper clearance and operation before riding the motorcycle.

## CARE AND MAINTENANCE

- Periodic cleaning will be necessary. Remove bugs and road grime from the hubs and bushings.
- Loosen the set screw at the base of the axle cap; remove the axle cap from the axle. See [PIC.2](#).
- Remove the two screws inside the base to separate the hub from the bushing. See [PIC.2](#).
- Lubricate hubs and bushings with dry graphite lubricant.
- Refer to [PIC.2](#) for the correct re-assembly of the axle caps.
