Only the Harley Davidson Ergo Bars have holes for internal wiring. The Metric Ergo Bars must be externally wired.

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PROCEDURE

STEP 1 Remove the fastener shown in <u>PIC. 1</u> and the bolt under this peg.

STEP 2 Remove the fastener shown in <u>PIC. 2</u>. You may need to loosen the top and bottom mounting bolts for ease of removal and reassembly. You are now able to set this part aside.

STEP 3 Using mechanics wire or other similar solid wire, feed it down the side tube through the hole shown in <u>PIC. 3</u>. This wire needs to come out of the location that is shown in <u>PIC. 4</u>. These two pictures were taken with the Ergo Guard off the bike to give you a more detailed photo.

STEP 4 Attach the wire from your light to the pull wire you just fed through. Twist the wires together then apply some electrical tape to the area. This joint must be small enough to go through the small hole at the top of the Ergo Guard. Pull the wire through the bar.

STEP 5 You can now reassemble the peg assembly in the reverse order that it was removed. The fastener shown in STEP 1 that secures the peg on must have Anti-Seize applied to it. The other two fasteners (one under peg and the one shown in <u>PIC. 2</u>) should have blue lock tight applied to them before installing.

STEP 6 Attach the light to the light mount bracket using the included 5/16"-18 x 1" SHCS.

IMPORTANT! Light mount must be attached in the furthest out most position. See <u>PIC. 5</u>.

STEP 7 Place the bracket in place and secure with the supplied fasteners. Anti-Seize must be used on these screws. The slotted holes are how you will adjust the lights vertically. See <u>PIC. 6</u>. You adjust the light's horizontal beam with its mounting bolt.

STEP 8 Slide the rubber grommet on wire and push in the top hole to protect wire. See <u>PIC. 7</u>. This photo shows the wire without the grommet.

REPEAT STEPS 1 THROUGH 8 FOR THE OPPOSITE SIDE.

STEP 9 Retighten the top and bottom mounting bolts.

NOTE: Please follow the instructions for Küryakyn P/N 2328 Wiring and Relay Kit to wire the lights.
