**PROCEDURE**

**STEP 1** Read and understand all steps in the instructions before starting the installation. Park the motorcycle on a hard, level surface; turn off the ignition and allow the engine to cool.

**STEP 2** Locate the two screws on the inside of the rear fender that secure the rear light bar. Remove these screws and set them aside for reinstallation.

**ATTENTION!** You may want to use masking tape or a soft cloth and apply that to the fender to prevent scratching or damaging the paint.

**STEP 3** Pull the light bar away from the bike and turn it over to the backside. Identify the two screws (PIC 1) that secure the stock license plate bracket and remove them. Set them aside, you will reuse this hardware with the new bracket.

**STEP 4** Take the new Back Plate (PIC 2) and secure it to the light bar with the screws that were removed in Step 3.

**STEP 5** Reinstall the light bar with the two screws that were removed in Step 2. Be sure that the rubber wire grommet (PIC 3) is in place before completely tightening the fasteners

**STEP 6** As shown in PIC 4, place the 1/2" Bumper Pads between the new Back Plate and the rear fender. Clean and dry the rear fender where the Bumper Pad will be installed. Peel the adhesive tape backing from the Bumper Pads, stack one on top of the other and stick to the fender over the plastic plug.

**NOTE** The bumper pads are provided to avoid excess vibration to the plate mount. The bumper pads may fit tightly when stacked and put in place behind the plate mount.

**ATTENTION!** Ensure the area of installation is free of grease, oil, dirt or other debris to ensure proper adhesion. Kuryakyn WILL NOT issue a warranty on any parts lost due to improper installation.

**ATTENTION!** The adhesive will not bond correctly if applied at temperatures less than 50°F. Do not attempt this installation in temperatures less than 50°F.

**STEP 7** Once you have the Back Plate secured you can install the license plate and secure the License Plate Frame (PIC 5) with the four 1/4-20 x 7/16 Flat Head Cap Screw. Tighten all fasteners.

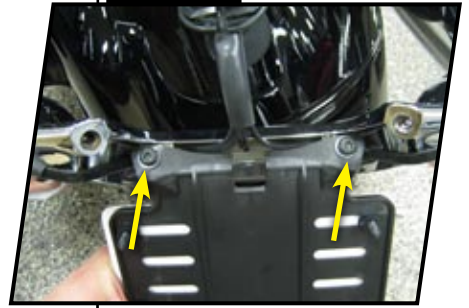
**NOTE** Due to the varying sizes of license plates, modification of the plate may be necessary to make it fit. If the plate fits loosely in the frame, the Adhesive Foam Strips can be installed between the Back Plate and the license plate to help stop vibration and avoid damage to the new frame or license plate.

**ATTENTION!** It is the installer's responsibility to ensure that all of the fasteners (including pre-assembled) are tightened before operation of the motorcycle. Kuryakyn will not issue a warranty on components lost due to improper installation. Periodic maintenance may be required.
