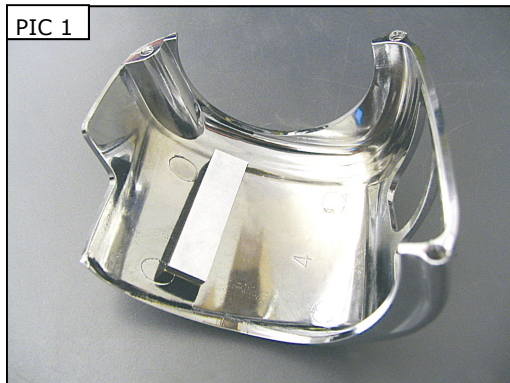

STEP 1

Read and understand all steps in the instructions before starting the installation. Park the motorcycle on a hard, level surface and turn off the ignition.

NOTE: For best appearance, motorcycle must be equipped with Kuryakyn Handlebar Control Dress-Up Kits (P/N 9119 or 9126) or H-D Handlebar Reservoir Cover Sets (H-D P/N 46099-98 or 46098-98)

STEP 2

Using the back of your fingernail, rub the brown adhesive backing on two foam pads to activate the catalyst, remove the backing and install the adhesive foam pads on the inside of the top covers as shown in PIC 1.

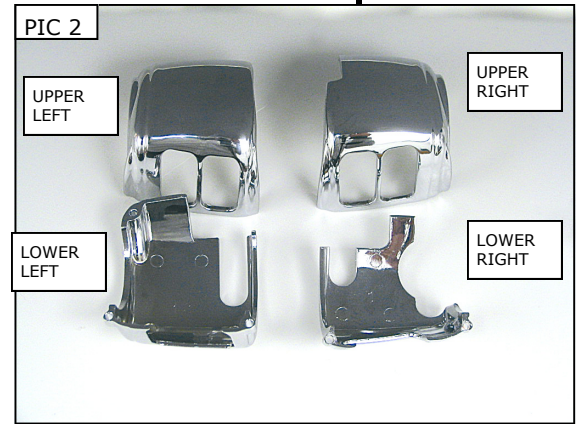

ATTENTION! Ensure the area of installation is free of grease, oil, dirt or other debris to ensure proper adhesion. Küryakyn **WILL NOT** warranty any parts lost due to improper installation.

ATTENTION! The adhesive will not bond correctly if applied at temperatures less than 50° F. Do not attempt this installation in temperatures less than 50°F.

STEP 3 Test fit the left upper and lower covers on the left switch housing (referring to PIC. 2 to determine the left covers).



NOTE: The covers are designed to have a small amount of movement when they are installed; if there is too much play, you can install an additional foam pad on the inside of the top cover.

STEP 4 Once the proper fit has been achieved, secure the top and bottom cover together using three screws from the hardware kit (two screws for the right side).

NOTE: You may choose to remove the adhesive backing on the foam pad that was installed on the cover before securing the top and bottom together.

STEP 5 Repeat STEP 3 and STEP 4 for the right side.

STEP 6 Check for clearance between the throttle grip and the cover, the throttle needs to operate freely; if it doesn't move freely, remove the cover and adjust the foam pads until the throttle will operate freely.

STEP 7 Test to make sure that all the switches and levers operate freely before riding the motorcycle.

CAUTION! Ensure that the installation of this product does not interfere with the proper operation of the motorcycle before riding.

ATTENTION! It is the installer's responsibility to ensure that all of the fasteners (including pre-assembled) are tightened before operation of the motorcycle. Küryakyn will not warranty components lost due to improper installation. Periodic maintenance may be required.
