TOOLS SUGGESTED

3/16". 5/32" Allen wrenches, 7/16" Combination wrench, Phillips screwdriver, Small "rat tail" file, Drill with 1/4" bit

NOTES

- **1)** Due to the large variation of license plate dimensions, hole patterns, etc., some trimming, hole slotting, or hole enlargement of the plate will most likely be required for proper fit.
- **2)** Not all of the included parts will be used in this installation. Components for two different mounting positions are supplied.
- **3)** It is up to the owner or end user of the product to determine if the repositioning of the plate conforms with local laws.

PROCEDURE AVERAGE TIME: 30 MINUTES

STEP 1 Remove the stock license plate bracket from the fender.

- **STEP 2** Determine which mounting position you desire. If you like the plate to stand up more upright, similar to the stock orientation, the larger "wedge" shaped rubber base will be used along with the 1-1/8" socket head bolts. If you want the plate to lie down and hug the contour of the fender, use the thin rubber base pad and the 3/4" socket head bolts.
- **STEP 3** See <u>PIC.1</u>. (Laydown position pictured note the placement of the thin rubber pad.) Install the license plate bracket with the appropriate base pad and bolts. Use the existing three holes in the fender from the stock bracket, or in custom applications the holes in the lay down bracket may be used as a drilling template. Place the nylock nuts on the mounting bolts inside of the fender. Make sure the bracket is centered and straight, and tighten securely.
- **STEP 4** Place the license plate on the plate bracket and determine if relocation of the holes in the plate is necessary. Drill or elongate the holes as needed.
- **STEP 5** Fasten the plate to the new lay down bracket using the button heads, flat washers, and nylock nuts provided.
